### Areas covered: Level 2

### Course Content

The main qualification is the **Diploma NVQ 2 / 3 in Body and Paint Operations**, gained in the workplace. The Apprentice will build a portfolio of proof of competence, comprising of witness testimony, photographs, direct observation and oral questioning.

On their day release they will be studying the **Diploma in Body and Paint Operations** which comprises of theory and practical sessions.

### Course duration and format

Normally 2 year for Level 2 dependant on prior knowledge and experience. One year for level 3. The Apprentice will spend 4 days in the workplace and attend College 1 day per week.
