Hairdressing

Level 2

- Make sure your own actions reduce the risk to health and safety
- Give clients a positive impression of yourself and your organisation
- Advise and consult with clients
- Shampoo, condition and treat the hair and scalp
- Style and finish hair
- Set and dress hair
- Cut hair using basic techniques
- Salon reception duties
- Promote additional services and or products to clients

Level 3

- Monitor procedures for Health and Safety
- Promote additional services or products to customers
- Creatively cut hair using a combination of techniques
- Colour hair using a variety of techniques
- Provide colour correction services
- Creatively style and dress hair
- Creatively dress long hair
- Develop and enhance your creative hairdressing skills
- Contribute to the financial effectiveness of the business

Course content

The main qualification is the **Diploma NVQ level 2 or 3**, which is gained in the workplace and during the college session. The Apprentice will build a portfolio of proof of competence in hairdressing, comprising of witness testimony, photographs, direct observation & oral questioning.

The apprentice will also gain a **Level 1 or 2 Key / Functional Skills in Maths and English**.

Course duration and format:

Normally 2 years for level 2 and 1 year for level 3, dependant on prior knowledge and experience. The apprentice will spend 4 days in the workplace and attend College 1 day per week. The college day is split into 3 sessions, A Maths/English session, a hairdressing theory session and a hairdressing practical session. The learners will need to buy a kit and uniform that they will need to bring each week to college, an order form for this will be given out prior to enrolment.
