Course Content

The main qualifications are the **Diploma NVQ2 and 3 in Bench Joinery or Site Carpentry**. These are gained in the workplace. The Apprentice will build a portfolio of proof of competence comprising of witness testimony, direct observation, oral question and photo/video evidence

Course Duration and format

The Level 2 course is 2 years and a further 1 year for the Level 3. The Apprentice will spend 4 days in the workplace and attend College 1 day per week
