- Diagnose and Rectify LV Engine & Components Faults
- Diagnose and Rectify LV chassis Systems Faults
- Diagnose and Rectify Auxiliary Equipment Electrical Faults

### Course Content

The main qualification is the **Diploma NVQ 2 / 3 in Vehicle Maintenance & Repair**, gained in the workplace. The Apprentice will build a portfolio of proof of competence, comprising of witness testimony, photographs, direct observation and oral questioning.

On their day release they will be studying the **Diploma in Vehicle Maintenance & Repair** which comprises of theory and practical sessions.

### Course duration and format

Normally 2 year for Level 2 and one year for Level 3, dependant on prior knowledge and experience. The Apprentice will spend 4 days in the workplace and attend College 1 day per week.
