Advanced Apprenticeship in Management

The Programme is designed for individuals who are looking to develop the skills and knowledge needed to be a successful manager.

Areas covered:

- Set objectives and provide support for team members
- Manage own personal development
- Plan, allocate and monitor work of the team

This programme also contains optional units which include - develop, maintain and review personal networks, managing risk in own area of responsibility, supporting team members in identifying, developing and implementing new ideas and managing conflict in a team.

Course Content

The main qualification include the ILM Level 3 NVQ Certificate in Management, gained in the workplace. The candidate will build a portfolio of proof of competence, comprising of witness testimonies, photographs, direct observations and oral questioning. Alongside this a Technical Certificate will be delivered at the same level, this will be assignment based and will be delivered on a weekday evening in College.

Candidates will work towards achieving Key Skills/ Functional Skills in Communication Level 2 and Application of Number Level 2.

Course duration and format

The course will take 12 months to complete, depending on the candidates prior knowledge and experience.
