Areas covered

- Understand and carry out safe working practices in building services engineering
- Understand how to communicate with others within Building Services engineering
- Understand how to apply environmental protection measures within BSE
- Understand how to apply scientific principles within mechanical services engineering
- Understand and carry out site preparation, and pipe work fabrication techniques for domestic plumbing and heating systems
- Understand and apply domestic cold / hot water / central heating system installation and maintenance techniques
- Understand and apply domestic rainwater system / above ground drainage system installation and maintenance techniques
- Apply safe working practices in building services engineering working environment
- Install and maintain domestic heating and / or plumbing systems

Course Content

The main qualifications at Level 2 are either the **Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Installing and Maintaining Domestic Heating Systems** or **Level 2 NVQ in Plumbing & Heating**. Progressions will be to **NVQ Level 3 Diploma in Domestic Plumbing and Heating** or **NVQ Level 3 Diploma in Domestic Heating**. These are gained in the workplace. The Apprentice will build a portfolio of proof of competence comprising of witness testimony, direct observation, oral question and photo/video evidence

Course Duration and format

Each course will run for 2 years. The Apprentice will spend 4 days in the workplace and attend College 1 day per week.
