N NO FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Tuition fees are payable by all students. Discounted fees are not available.

M ENGLISH AND MATHS

GCSE maths, GCSE English and functional skills maths and English course fees may be free if you haven't already obtained a grade 4 (C) or above in these subjects.

1 ENTRY OR LEVEL 1

If you are a Greater Manchester resident, and meet the unemployed criteria, or are employed, including where the low wage flexibility may apply, (or are aged 19-23 and non GM resident) and don't already hold a qualification equivalent to 5 GCSEs at grade 4 (C) or above, and you need to study at Entry or Level 1 to progress to Level 2, tuition fees will be waived.

2F FULL LEVEL 2

If you are a Greater Manchester resident, and meet the unemployed criteria, or are employed, including where the low wage flexibility may apply, (or aged 19-23 and non GM resident) and don't already hold a qualification equivalent to 5 GCSEs at grade 4 (C) or above, tuition fees will be waived.

2 OTHER LEVEL 2

If you are aged 19-23, meet the unemployed criteria, or earn less than £18,525 annual gross salary, **and** already hold a qualification equivalent to 5 GCSEs at grade 4 (C) or above, tuition fees will be waived.

If you are aged 19-23 and don't meet the unemployed criteria, and already hold a qualification equivalent to 5 GCSEs at grade 4 (C) or above, tuition fees are payable.

If you are aged 19-23 and do not already hold a qualification equivalent to 5 GCSEs at grade 4 (C) or above, full fees are payable.

If you are aged 24+ and meet the unemployed criteria, or earn less than £18,525 annual gross salary, tuition fees will be waived.

If you are aged 24+ and don't meet the unemployed criteria, or earn less than £18,525. annual gross salary, tuition fees are payable

3F FULL LEVEL 3

If you are aged between 19-23 and you don't have a qualification equivalent to 2 A-Levels, tuition fees will be waived.

If aged 19-23, and you do have a qualification equivalent to 2 A-Levels at the start of the course see the section on Advanced Learner loans, or tuition fees are payable.

If you are aged over 23 at the start of the course see the section on Advanced Learner loans, or tuition fees are payable.

A OTHER LEVEL 3 OR ABOVE (NOT HIGHER EDUCATION)

If you are aged 19+ at the start of the course please refer to the section on Advanced Learner loans on **page 5** of this document.

H HIGHER EDUCATION

Financial support could be available through Student Finance England.

G GOVERNMENT FUNDED

Tuition fees will be waived if:

(Not in paid employment)

You are unemployed, seeking work and in receipt of a means tested benefit.

Or economically inactive - (GM Residents only).

If you are unemployed and seeking work, but are not in receipt of a means tested benefit.

(In paid employment)

You receive a means tested benefit accepted by the college; are working less than 20 hours per week and have an income of £343 per month (individual claims) or £549 per month (household claims).

OR, You earn less than £18,525 annual gross salary **AND** the course you are studying will help you find or improve your employment.

This also applies to all courses labelled level 1 or 2F.
