Course Content

The Main Qualification is a NVQ Level 2 Diploma in Decorative Finishing gained in the workplace. The apprentice will build a portfolio of proof of competence, comprising of witness testimony, direct observations, oral questioning and photographs.

On their Day release the apprentice will be studying the Level 2 Diploma in Painting and Decorating (Construction) which comprises of theory and practical sessions. Apprentices will work towards achieving Level 1 Functional skills in English, Maths and ICT

Course duration and format

Normally 2 years for Level 2 dependent on prior knowledge and experience. The Apprentice will spend 4 days a week in the workplace and attend college 1 day a week.
