The Programme is designed for people who wish to work with Children from 0-5 years.

Areas covered:

- Develop communication skills in health, social care or children and young people's settings
- Understand how to safeguard the well being of children and young people

Course Content

Apprentices

- Level 2 Certificate for the Children and Young Peoples Workforce
- Level 2 Award in Employment Responsibilities and Rights in Children and Young People's Settings
- Level 1 Functional Skills in Maths, English and ICT

Advanced Apprentices

- Level 3 Diploma for the Early Years Workforce (Early Years Educator)
- Level 2 Award in Employment Responsibilities and Rights in Children and Young Peoples Settings
- Functional Skills Level 2 ICT

*Candidates must achieve A-C GCSE grades in Maths and English prior to starting the Advanced Childcare Apprenticeship

Course duration and format:

12 months to complete the Level 2 Apprenticeship. 20 months to complete the Advanced Apprenticeship depending on the candidate's prior knowledge and achievement. Training for the Diploma and Certificate is completed in the workplace. Functional Skills will be attended and completed at College.
