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### Course Content

The Main Qualification is a Diploma VCQ Level 2/3 in Paint Refinishing gained in the workplace. The apprentice will build a portfolio of proof of competence, comprising of witness testimony, direct observations, oral questioning and photographs.

On their Day release the apprentice will be studying the Diploma in Paint Refinishing which comprises of theory and practical sessions. Apprentices will work towards achieving Functional skills in English, Maths and ICT

### Course duration and format

Normally 2 years for Level 2 dependent on prior knowledge and experience. One year for level 3. The Apprentice will spend 4 days a week in the workplace and attend college 1 day a week.
