Course Content

The main qualification is the Diploma NVQ 2 / 3 in Trowel Occupations, gained in the workplace. The Apprentice will build a portfolio of proof of competence, comprising of witness testimony, photographs, direct observation and oral questioning.

In addition, the apprentice will also complete Functional Skill Level 1 in both Maths & English.

On their day release they will be studying the Diploma in Brickwork which comprises of theory and practical sessions.

Course duration and format

Normally 2 years for Level 2 and one year for Level 3 dependent on prior knowledge and experience. The Apprentice will spend 4 days in the workplace and attend College 1 day per week.
