## Hairdressing

### Level 2

- // Make sure your own actions reduce the risk to health and safety
- // Give clients a positive impression of yourself and your organisation
- // Advise and consult with clients
- // Shampoo, condition and treat the hair and scalp
- // Style and finish hair
- // Set and dress hair
- // Cut hair using basic techniques
- // Salon reception duties
- // Promote additional services or products to clients

### Level 3

- // Monitor procedures for Health and Safety
- // Promote additional services or products to customers
- // Creatively cut hair using a combination of techniques
- // Colour hair using a variety of techniques
- // Provide colour correction services
- // Creatively style and dress hair
- // Creatively dress long hair
- // Develop and enhance your creative hairdressing skills
- // Contribute to the financial effectiveness of the business

### Course content

The main qualification is the Diploma NVQ Level 2 or 3, which is gained in the workplace and during the college session. The Apprentice will build a portfolio of proof of competence in hairdressing, comprising of witness testimony, photographs, direct observation and oral questioning.

The apprentice will also gain a Level 1 or 2 Functional Skills in Maths and English.

### Course duration and format:

Normally 2 years for level 2 and 1 year for level 3, dependent on prior knowledge and experience. The apprentice will spend 4 days in the workplace and attend College 1 day per week. The college day is split into 3 sessions: a Maths/English session, a hairdressing theory session and a hairdressing practical session. The learners will need to buy a kit and uniform that they will need to bring each week to college, an order form for this will be given out prior to enrolment.
