

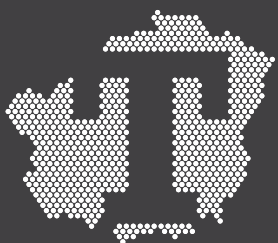

## Evidence you must have for us to assess your fees and available remission:

Wage slip from the last 3 months, which shows gross salary.

Bank statement, or online evidence, from the last 3 months which shows the benefit being paid into the bank.

Letter, or online evidence, from Department for Work and Pensions (DWP), dated in the last 3 months. For joint claims the student must be named on the claim.

Council tax benefit: a letter from the local authority or council tax statement for the current year.

## MAKING SURE YOU CAN ENROL

Tameside College wants to make sure your interview and enrolment is easy, safe and personal.

To help us, we need you to apply online at: [www.tameside.ac.uk](http://www.tameside.ac.uk)

When coming along to your appointment, please make sure you have the payment for your course or relevant documentation (dated within 3 months of the start of the course). Documentation to be provided can be proof of means tested benefit, wage slip if annual gross salary is below £19,890.00 or a letter of support from your employer if they are funding your fees.

**We also need your national insurance number.**

### PAYING FOR YOUR COURSE

You can pay for your course by cash, cheque, credit/debit card or direct debit. If you wish to pay by direct debit you must bring with you your bank details including full address, account number and sort code.

Direct debit is not available for some short courses and a minimum tuition fee applies. You can pay over up to six instalments, depending on the tuition fee. The first payment must be made when you enrol. If your company is paying for your tuition, please bring a letter from your employer on letter headed paper so the College can invoice them directly.

### COURSE FEES

The tuition fees shown in this guide refer to the cost of the course in this academic year.

The only exception to this is when the course duration is 2 years and an Advanced Learner loan is used to pay for the course. In this case the fee paid is for the duration of the course.

Tuition fees don't include professional body membership fees, or DBS checks where required.

Tuition fees will be confirmed at the time of enrolment. Individual eligibility and entitlement will be assessed at the time of enrolment.

## FUNDING FOR YOUR STUDIES

### SUPPORT FOR STUDENTS ON LOW INCOMES OR IN FINANCIAL HARDSHIP

Even if you don't meet the requirements for free study, you could still get help with your tuition fees through the adult support fund.

### FINANCIAL SUPPORT

If you are studying on a course which is Government funded you may be able to get help towards costs such as books, travel, equipment and childcare. ### TUITION FEE LOANS FOR HIGHER EDUCATION (HE) COURSES

New part-time and full-time students enrolling on HE courses are eligible for a student loan to cover tuition fees. Loans are not dependent on your income and do not affect any benefits you may receive. They accrue interest at a preferential rate and are not repayable until you are earning more than **£524** per week, **£2,274** per month or **£27,295** per year.

## FREE COURSES FOR JOBS OFFER...

This gives eligible adults the chance to **access their first Level 3 qualification for free**. Also any adult who is earning less than £19,890.00, or is unemployed, will be able to access the identified qualifications for free, regardless of their prior qualification level.

# ADVANCED LEARNER LOANS

If you are aged 19 or over and studying at Level 3 or above you can apply for an Advanced Learner loan to help with the cost of your course.

Loans are not dependent on your income and do not affect any benefits you may receive. It's easy to apply and you will only start making repayments when your income is more than **£524** per week, **£2,274** per month or **£27,295** per year.

## Did you know?

Applicants to Access to HE courses will have their Advanced Learner Loan written off if they progress onto and complete a HE Course which is eligible for Student Finance.

## ELIGIBILITY

To qualify for the loan you must be:

- Aged 19 or over on the first day of your course (there's no upper age-limit) and starting your course on or after 1 August 2022.
- Living in the UK on the first day of your course and have lived in the UK for three years immediately before this, or have Settled Status in the UK. Other students may be eligible, check the .gov website for details.
- Enrolling on an eligible course at Level 3 or above which includes: A levels, Access to HE Diplomas, other Diplomas and Certificates.

## HOW MUCH WILL YOU GET?

Funding will depend on the type of course you wish to take. The minimum loan you can get is £300, however you don't have to borrow the full fee amount; you can pay the remainder of the fee yourself.

## HOW TO APPLY

To apply for an Advanced Learner loan you can go online or download the form from the Student Loans Company. You'll get a letter confirming your loan usually within 2 weeks if you apply online, however postal applications may take longer. **You need to complete your loan application before you enrol.**

## REPAYMENTS

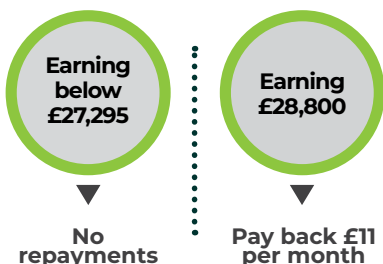
You'll be due to start repaying your loan in the April after you leave or complete your course, whichever comes first. You pay back your loan (plus interest) when you finish your course and are earning more than £524 per week, £2,274 per month or £27,295 per year. You pay interest from the day the first payment is made to the College until your loan has been paid back in full.

Your repayments will stop if your income drops below £524 per week, £2,274 per month or £27,295 per year. Your monthly repayment amount will be 9% of any income you earn over £524 per week, £2,274 per month or £27,295 per year.

## **N** NO FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Tuition fees are payable by all students. Discounted fees are not available.

## **M** ENGLISH AND MATHS

GCSE maths, GCSE English and functional skills maths and English course fees are free if you haven't already obtained a grade 4 (C) or above in these subjects.

## **E** ESOL

If you are 19 and over, undertaking an Entry Level, Level 1 or Level 2 ESOL course, you will be exempt from paying fees if you receive an active benefit (e.g. Universal Credit, ESA, JSA or Child Tax Credit) and are seeking work, or are employed where the low wage flexibility applies.

## **1** ENTRY OR LEVEL 1

If you are a Greater Manchester resident, and meet the unemployed criteria, or are employed where the low wage flexibility applies, (or are aged 19-23 and non GM resident) and don't already hold a qualification equivalent to 5 GCSEs at grade 4 (C) or above, and you need to study at Entry or Level 1 to progress to Level 2, tuition fees will be waived.

## **2F** FULL LEVEL 2

If you are a Greater Manchester resident, and meet the unemployed criteria, or are employed where the low wage flexibility applies, (or aged 19-23 and non GM resident) and don't already hold a qualification equivalent to 5 GCSEs at grade 4 (C) or above, tuition fees will be waived. 5 GCSEs at grade 4 (C) or above, tuition fees will be waived.

## **2** OTHER LEVEL 2

If you are aged 19-23, meet the unemployed criteria, or earn less than £19,890.00 annual gross salary, **and** already hold a qualification equivalent to 5 GCSEs at grade 4 (C) or above, tuition fees will be waived.

If you are aged 19-23 and don't meet the unemployed criteria, and already hold a qualification equivalent to 5 GCSEs at grade 4 (C) or above, tuition fees are payable.

If you are aged 19-23 and do not already hold a qualification equivalent to 5 GCSEs at grade 4 (C) or above, full fees are payable.

If you are aged 24+ and meet the unemployed criteria, or earn less than £19,890.00 annual gross salary, tuition fees will be waived.

If you are aged 24+ and don't meet the unemployed criteria, or you earn more than £19,890.00 annual gross salary, tuition fees are payable.

## **3F** FULL LEVEL 3

If you are aged between 19-23 and you don't have a qualification equivalent to 2 A-Levels, tuition fees will be waived.

If aged 19-23, and you do have a qualification equivalent to 2 A-Levels at the start of the course see the section on Advanced Learner loans, or tuition fees are payable. If you are aged over 23 at the start of the course see the section on Advanced Learner loans, or tuition fees are payable.

## **A** OTHER LEVEL 3 OR ABOVE (NOT HIGHER EDUCATION)

If you are aged 19+ at the start of the course please refer to the section on Advanced Learner loans.

## **H** HIGHER EDUCATION

Financial support could be available through Student Finance England.

## **G** GOVERNMENT FUNDED

Tuition fees will be waived if:

### **(Not in paid employment)**

You are unemployed, seeking work and in receipt of a means tested benefit.

Or economically inactive – (GM Residents only).

If you are unemployed and seeking work, but are not in receipt of a means tested benefit.

### **(In paid employment)**

You receive a means tested benefit accepted by the college; are working less than 20 hours per week and have an income of £343 per month (individual claims) or £549 per month (household claims).

**OR**, You earn less than £19,890.00 annual gross salary **AND** the course you are studying will help you find or improve your employment

**This also applies to all courses labelled level 1 or 2F.**

# YOUR GUIDE TO FUNDING (continued)

## 01 FREE COURSES

These courses are available to all **adult** learners, no matter your employment status, but if you are:

**Not in paid employment and receiving a means tested benefit** - please bring with you current dated benefit documentation

**In paid employment but with an annual gross salary of less than £19,890.00** - please bring with you a wage slip dated within 3 months of the start of the course.

## 02 FREE COURSES LEVEL 2

These courses are available to all **adult** learners, no matter your employment status, but if you are:

**Not in paid employment and receiving a means tested benefit** - please bring with you current dated benefit documentation

**In paid employment but with an annual gross salary of less than £19,890.00** - please bring with you a wage slip dated within 3 months of the start of the course.

If you are aged 19-23 as well as meeting the benefit criteria you will also need to hold a full level 2 qualification.

## Acceptable Evidence:

### Low wage:

- A wage slip from the last 3 months, which shows gross salary.

### Means tested benefit:

- Bank statement or show online banking from the last 3 months, which shows the benefit being paid into the bank, or a letter from DWP, dated in the last 3 months.
- For joint claims the student must be named on the claim.
- Online evidence can be shown.
- Council tax benefit: letter from the local authority or council tax statement for the current year.

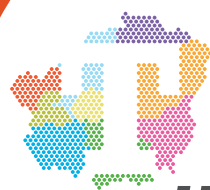
