## COURSE CONTENT

- The main qualification is the Level 2 Diploma in Vehicle Accident Repair, Paint Refinishing
- The apprenticeship is completed through the compilation of a portfolio showing competence in the form of photographs, witness statements and assessor observations
- Training must include **20% off the job training**, which is undertaken outside of the normal day-to-day working environment and leads towards the achievement of an apprenticeship. This can include training that is delivered at the apprentice's normal place of work, but must not be delivered as part of their normal working duties
- Apprentices will also achieve level 1 functional skills in maths, English and ICT, if required

## DURATION / COURSE FORMAT

- This apprenticeship takes 24 months to complete, dependent on prior knowledge and experience
- The apprentice will spend 4 days in the workplace and attend college 1 day per week
